Dover Town Council - Frontline Support for our Community

New challenges bring new opportunities and fresh thinking. Councillors have agreed an increased budget of £30,000 to organise a socially distanced celebration of Christmas as the popular Community Switch-On will not be possible this year. The Dover Fire Garden will be a spectacular start to the festive season in the Town Centre on 28-29 November. Free to local people but booking essential- Keep an eye on the DTC website and other local media for details.

Are you a local person with a good business idea? Need a bit of help to get going? DTC is funding the Pop-Up Business School in Dover with partners Dover Big Local and a grant of £3,250 for on-line delivery of an easy to understand tool kit for your start-up. The support is free – contact Dover Big Local at the Charlton Centre for details. Councillors voting to give the grant were told of someone who, having attended a previous course, now employs over 100 people – pretty good value all round!

Some families in our community are finding life tough. Social Supermarkets can help reduce hardship by providing food and other necessities at cheaper prices to those in need. DTC is granting £10,000 to help set up a Social Supermarket in Dover – a much needed first in the local area.

Councillors are looking ahead – following extensive consultation, the Dover Town Council Ambition Plan 2020-23, is now in place providing a flexible road-map for the next 3 years with a strong emphasis on sustainable eco-friendly development in Dover.
